



PER I TURISTI STRANIERI: GUIDARE IN ITALIA

- **BIKES AND CYCLE PATHS**

Cyclists must not carry any burdens or anything hindering their arms and legs when riding. They must hold the handlebar with at least one hand. Cyclists must also wear reflective jacket or braces when riding outside built-up areas from half an hour after sunset to half an hour before sunrise. They must always wear reflective jacket or braces when riding in tunnels, both in built-up areas and outside.

FINE for non-compliance (article 182, paragraph 9bis and 10, Italian Highway Code): 25 to 99 Euros.
